It is intended as a platform to network, share experiences and debate issues of sustainability and buildings. Abstract to be submitted in MSWord-document by **8th March** (events@lolo.ac.uk) and should contain the following:

- Title of the submission
- Maximum three of the conference themes the abstract falls under
- Author name(s), academic affiliation and email and phone number of corresponding author
- Abstract of maximum 350 words

All abstracts will be peer-reviewed by a panel of research students from Loughborough University and UCL. Abstracts will be published electronically and available in the conference pack.
