Bukky is an experienced environmental engineer with a background in mechanical building services. In her current role at Tesco, Bukky is responsible for shaping the strategy to deliver Tesco's sustainability targets in relation to its built estate. Her focus is on the research, development and implementation of low carbon design and technology, and to ensure a cohesive approach within the business.

Tesco acknowledges the impacts its operations can have on the environment and is committed to reducing these through sustainable development of the estate, as well as investment in new technologies. Work to support the reduction in greenhouse gas emissions in the built estate includes, amongst others, continually redesigning the standard store to improve its energy efficiency and increase its environmental sustainability criteria and investment in renewable technology.

Such initiatives significantly impact the management and operation of the estate, and Bukky will speak about Tesco's interests and priorities for low carbon initiatives, as well as the opportunities and obstacles in meeting these challenges.
